

Great Building Program Planned For Okeechobee

OKEECHOBEE, July 22.—Okeechobee's hour is striking now. One of the greatest building programs in South Florida is now scheduled for Okeechobee and a great part of it is already being constructed. Lon A. Hough, owner and developer of El Mira Sol, and one of Okeechobee's pioneers, stated that more than \$3,500,000.00 worth of new buildings were under construction, started or scheduled for Okeechobee within the next few weeks.

Among the new buildings are 21 new business stores on South Park street out toward El Mira Sol. Seven of these new buildings are being built by Fordhan and Kirkland, of Miami, and are already under construction, while the contract has been let by a Jacksonville syndicate for the construction of 14 additional stores, the contract being let to C.
